Useful Information/ Polite Requests:

Pre-school opens at 9am. We offer staggered pick up and drop off between 9 -9.30 am and 2.30-3.00pm at pickup to allow for drop off at the infant and junior school and to avoid too much waiting.

Please provide your child with:

- A named snack
- A named water bottle
- A change of clothes
- Nappies and wipes if relevant.
- Lunch box if your child is attending for a full day
- Named coat and bag.

If your child is going to be absent, please let the pre-school know either by phone or email or via a member of staff.

Please keep staff updated on any relevant information about your child i.e., medical conditions, allergies, changes of address or contact details etc

If you provide your child with grapes or any other similar shaped food, please cut them longways to help prevent chocking hazards.



If you have any special skill, job, or hobby you would like to share with the staff and children please speak to a member of staff we would love to hear all about it.

Term dates will be sent out in due course and can also be found on the pre-school website.

Faringdon pre-school has a closed group Facebook page. This is only for the parents of the children that attend pre-school and once your child leaves you are removed from the group. We use the Facebook page to keep parents updated on all the latest information. Parents can message on pre-school messenger between 7am-7pm and staff will get back to you as soon as possible.

Children WILL get wet and dirty at pre-school from time to time and some paint and other resources have been known to stain, so please do not dress your child in clothes that you do not want to get dirty. We do not judge!

There are sharing sacks available at pre-school for your child to take home and share with you. Please bring these back to pre-school when you have finished with them, thank you.

We like the children to make the most of the outdoor area in all weather.

On hotter days please ensure your child has sun cream on and brings a sun hat to pre-school with them.

On colder day please ensure your child has appropriate outdoor clothing i.e. coat, hat, gloves, and wellington boots.

Your child will be given a communication book and a book bag once they start pre-school. The communication book can be very useful to pass messages back and forth in between verbal communication. These can be used for any relevant information about your child that may be useful to know for example an achievement, a bad night, an upcoming event, on going feedback, behaviour, potty training, notes from us about something at pre-school. ANYTHING! These will generally be used by your child's keyperson.

Please remember we aim to work in partnership with parents to provide yourselves and your child with the best possible experience at Faringdon Preschool.
